Updated COVID Procedures and Protocols

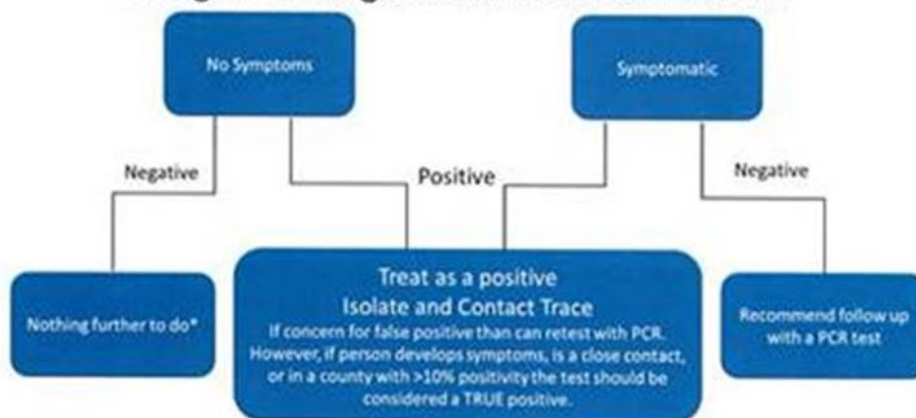
Close contact is now defined as being within six feet of a positive person for a **TOTAL of 15 minutes, not necessarily consecutive.

If an individual has been in close contact with someone who **has tested positive**, per the Boone County Health Department, a negative rapid Covid test result will no longer be accepted. Documentation of a negative PCR test is required in order for the individual to return to ZYSA.

* If there is high clinical suspicion (close contact) or the patient becomes symptomatic consider follow up PCR testing
