Pickering Soccer Club has been an active participant in the Durham Region since 1984. The Club houses competitive teams, ranging from the ages of 8 to 21 in the youth division, with approximately 300 youth members playing competitive soccer year-round, and League 1 men's and women's teams in the senior division. As 1 of only 39 clubs in Canada to be awarded the CSA National Youth Club License our coaching staff provide quality programming for all of the players in both the recreational and competitive streams.

Pickering Soccer Club is a forward-thinking organization delivering sustainable programs on and off the field in order to develop players through a proven, age specific, systematic curriculum. The club has contributed to the development of the game, with many players going on to play at Canadian Universities, NCAA, and Provincial Teams as well as our Canadian National Teams.

Overview:

As part of the technical staff of PSC and reporting to the Director of Coaching, this position is responsible for providing leadership and the oversight of the development of one of the OPDL teams in the High Performance Stream. It also includes the player development that is aligned with the Club's Vision and Mission. The position assists in the management of all aspects of the OPDL team including; games, practices, off-field activities, season planning and curriculum delivery.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

• Technical

- Plan, develop, and execute age appropriate training sessions and curriculum in alignment with the Ontario Soccer Long-Term Player Development program.
- Assist in conducting three training sessions per week, **but take lead in 1 of 3 sessions** (November to October) plus one game/week (April 15th to September 30th)
- Assist in the scouting, identification and selection of players of the OPDL Players.

- Support and implement the Club style of play for the competitive teams.
 - Assist with the monitoring of off-field fitness program in partnership with the Strength and Conditioning Coach.
 - Travel with the team and attend all competitions and showcase events.
- **Administration**
 - Coordinate and administer the Club's policies established by the Board of Directors
 - Assist with player reports and evaluations as per OPDL Guidelines
 - Attend all Coaches Meetings related to High Performance. PSC, OPDL and CPD events
 - Monthly parents meeting to ensure open team communications.
- **Customer Service & External Relations**
 - Support the quality of the Club's services, ensuring maximum membership satisfaction.
 - Participate in outside activities deemed appropriate and approved by the Executive Director to enhance the image of the Club.
 - Broaden the scope of the Club by fulfilling public obligations as a participating member of the Pickering Community where needed.
