Kirk S Nevin Arena Guidelines

We are following the CDC and Local Health authorities recommendations for Social Distancing and wearing Face Masks.

Masks are required in the building with the exception of coaches and players when on the ice surface (excused with a valid health reason)

THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES WILL BE IN PLACE FOR THE START OF THE 2020/2021 ICE SEASON SEPTEMBER 8TH!

- Only ONE Parent/Guardian with each player permitted in the building. Please make plans for siblings to stay home.
- DO NOT arrive any earlier than 15 minutes before your scheduled tryout times.
- Come to the rink with the majority of your gear on.
- Locker rooms - **IF OPEN** - will HAVE A LIMIT OF 10 PLAYERS PER ROOM and disinfected before & after each teams use. If the locker room you are assigned to is crowded, you may use the lobby, BUT please keep space between players.
- Please exit the building as quickly as possible at the end of your scheduled time.
- All Players must bring their own water, no sharing.
- Please leave Locker Room doors open ... DO NOT bring valuables.
- Please monitor your health. If your temperature is 100 degree or over, please stay home.

The arena staff will periodically disinfect the locker rooms (ref and girls also) lobby and lobby restrooms during the hours we are open. We will be using an electric mister and hospital grade cleaning solution.

The Scorers box and Team boxes will be misted periodically. Hand Sanitizer will be in the Scorers box.

We are trying our best to keep our arena clean but please be aware that there is a level of responsibility on your part for your own safety and that of your families. We care about our employees' health in addition to yours.
