Registration Changes

2026 registration will be coming up soon. Corryn will send an email as a draft of how to ask about medical conditions.

Corryn looked at many different youth sports registrations, specifically at the volunteer structure. The current SBAA fee of \$100 is the lowest volunteer fee that was found.

Motion to have an option to pay the \$200 volunteer fee if paid up front (and then forgo their volunteer commitment) or parents who intend to volunteer and then fail to do so will be charged \$400 at the end of the season, by Terry, seconded by Matt. Motion passes.

One Checkbook

Currently, we have 5 checkbooks. It makes the most sense to combine the checkbooks and have 5 classes. This would start January 2026.

Capital Improvements

They had their first meeting and they will present a better update next month.

Solution was presented with an idea on how to utilize the existing running water at Lion's Park. The idea is to install a 300 gallon gray tank, a water heater and then install a

3 compartment sink. This would follow all the codes necessary for the concessions permits.
