Hams Cheerleading Commitment Summary

Welcome to Hempfield Association For Midget Sports (HAMS) Cheerleading. We are excited for your interest in the HAMS cheerleading program. Our cheerleading program has proved to be both rewarding and successful over the years and we look forward to continuing this tradition. Prior to tryouts, we would like you to understand the time and financial commitment of our program. A listing of important items is inventoried below. There may be additional competition costs as well if your daughter participates in competitions. The items and the costs per item are only our best estimate. ESTIMATED Costs:

Each cheerleader is responsible to purchase the following (approximate costs):

- • Bodysuit - \$25 (if needed in uniform)
- • Socks - \$10 (2 pairs)
- • Cheer sneakers - \$50
- • Warm up pants - \$30
- • Hempfield Cheerleading warm-up jacket - \$40
- Personalized Hams Cheer Mask
- Cheer bow
- Bloomers

All cheerleaders are required to pay a \$85.00 registration fee once the participant completes tryouts and is placed on a team. Families are also required to participate in a fundraiser during the season. There is an opt out fee if you do not wish to sell items. More information on fundraisers will be discussed in August.

Summer Practices:

Summer practices are mandatory and will begin in early August, times TBA. Most practices will be in the evening; however, we will have a few days with morning practices.

Other mandatory practices:

- All cheerleading practices and games are considered mandatory. We follow a strict attendance policy that we will cover at a scheduled parent meeting at a later date. Most teams will practice two days per week during the regular season. Additional practices will be added for girls participating in competition.

Constitution

1. MISSION

The mission of HAMS Cheerleading is to provide a quality program for ALL our participants grades 2-8. Our purpose is to provide inspiration, enthusiasm and support for our football program through cheers and performances and to give our athletes an opportunity to show their skills and talent in the competition arena. Our athletes will develop fundamental cheer skills while reinforcing and encouraging teamwork, sportsmanship and a positive self-image. As an organization we want to ensure that all participants have a positive experience, which in turn will create an enthusiastic attitude towards the HAMS Organization and our community.

2. CONDUCT

All squad members must remember that they are representatives of their school and community and must reflect good judgment and appropriate behavior both inside and outside of school.

2.1 Any cheerleader participating in bullying, harassment or malicious gossip will not be tolerated.

2.2 Disrespectful behavior towards the coaches or fellow cheerleaders could result in suspension from game and/or possible dismissal.

2.3 Inappropriate language could constitute suspension from game and/or possible dismissal.

2.4 Unsportsmanlike conduct shown to any opposing team or squad will result in suspension from game and/or possible dismissal.

3 GAMES

Attendance at ALL games (Playoffs included) is mandatory.

3.1 A cheerleader will not be allowed to miss a game due to reasons other than illness, previously scheduled church or school function (prior approval required) or death of a family member.

3.2 Missing a game for any reason, other than illness, previously scheduled church or school function (prior approval required) or death of a family member will constitute an unexcused game absence. **Three** unexcused absences from practices/games could result in dismissal from the team.

3.3 If a cheerleader is unable to cheer at a game due to injury, she is still expected to attend the game in complete uniform.

3.4 All cheerleaders will be expected to arrive at least 1 hour before the start of every game in complete uniform. This will allow time to warm-up, stretch, and review material before the game begins. Cheerleaders are required to bring their duffle bag to every game with the following items but not limited to (wind breaker, warmup pants, bodysuits, extra shoes, cover up t-shirt and water bottle).

3.5 Arrive to the games in complete uniform.

3.6 Arriving late to a game could constitute benching at the coaches discretion.

3.7 No socializing during the game. Halftime visits are allowed.

3.8 Eating is not permitted during the games, including gum.

3.9 Only water or sports drinks allowed during the games.

4. PRACTICES

4.1 Practices are mandatory and the unexcused policy will be strictly enforced. The only excused absence is illness, previously scheduled church or school function (prior approval required) or death of a family member. If a squad member must miss a practice for any reason other than these, an unexcused absence will be given and a warning will be issued. **A phone call to the coach is required prior to any absence during the season.**

Three unexcused absences from practices/games could result in dismissal from the team.

4.2 Practice schedules will be determined by the director. Every effort will be made to keep any changes to a minimum.

4.3 Summer practices will begin week of August 8. During the two weeks of summer practices, there may also be practices in the mornings.

4.4 Starting August 26th, practices will be held 2 days per week for 2 hours.

4.5 Practices may increase to 3 times a week prior to competition.

4.6 If a cheerleader is unable to practice due to injury, or mild illness, she is still expected to attend the practice.

4.7 It is expected that all squad members arrive on time.

4.8 Only water or sports drinks are allowed at practices.

5. COMPETITION

Competition events are usually in late October, early November

5.1 Squads may attend competitions approved by the director.

5.2 If competing, attendance to all practices and events having to do with competition are required.

5.3 All rules of eligibility, including conduct apply to the competition as well.

5.4 Any squad member suspended from the team is also suspended from participation in the competition.

6. APPEARANCE

For all games, practices and cheerleading events.

6.1 Hair must be securely pulled back away from the face.

6.2 Fingernails must be short and free of nail polish. No artificial nails permitted.

6.3 No jewelry allowed! This includes belly button rings that must be removed before any cheerleading activity.

6.4 Uniforms and shoes must be kept clean and neat at all times.

6.5 No part of the uniform may be worn for any activity except games and competition, unless otherwise directed by the coach. This includes the shoes.

6.6 At no time shall any part of a cheerleader's uniform/warm-ups be worn by anyone other than the cheerleader.

7. PARENT INVOLVEMENT

Please be realistic about your ability and your family's ability to make this commitment.

7.1 Parents are expected to participate in Booster Club fundraising activities.

7.2 Parents are responsible for purchasing certain necessary cheerleading apparel and all accessories, as outlined in the HAMS Commitment form.

7.3 All uniform will be assigned to participants in August. Parents will be required to submit a check covering the cost of the uniform at distribution. The check will be returned to the parent at the end of the season unless the uniform is not returned or returned in poor condition by the specified date.

7.4 Inappropriate behavior by a parent towards a director, coach, teen helper or cheerleader could result in the parent being banned from the premises. (This includes all practices, games (home or away) or competitions).

7.5 Parents that have concerns or questions about anything concerning cheerleading should talk to the coach first. After talking with the coach; if the parent still have concerns, the parent should contact the cheerleading director.

7.6 As with any sport, cheerleading does carry a risk of physical injury. No matter how careful the participant and coaches are, how many spotters are used, or what landing surface is used, the risk cannot be eliminated. We will do everything to keep your child safe but accidents do and will happen.

To ensure we are properly prepared to participate in these competitions, we have to plan as though we are attending. As you know, cheerleading is a team driven sport and requires 100% commitment from all those involved (Cheerleaders, parents, coaches, and team helpers). Please review the guidelines below and sign to indicate your commitment.

- We plan to participate in 2-3 competitions
- We will look into competitions that will be within a 45-mile radius
- Beginning in October, there will be an increase in practice days
- Practices can run a little longer
- Practices can be added on a different week night
- Practices may be held over the weekend
- Competition practices are mandatory
- Major life events (Weddings, funerals, etc.) are excusable with appropriate notice given
- Missing competition-oriented practices may result in dismissal from the competition routine
- Possible competition dates are as follows: October 16-17, October 23-24, October 30-31, November 6-7, November 13-14
