

Central St. Croix Rec is a community-based organization fully run by volunteers. Therefore, all participating families are required to help support the activities of the association through volunteer hours. To ensure the workload is somewhat balanced, CSCR is implementing minimum work hour requirements by family for each sport. Each sport has different volunteer needs which means each sport will have different requirements. Specific hour requirements will be announced approximately one month prior to registration opening and acknowledgment will be required upon registration. Single-parent households may apply to the CSCR Board for a reduction in work hours, which the Board will review and make determinations on a case-by-case basis.

Parents will be required to track their volunteer hours through a SportsEngine Dibs account. This will be linked to your child's registration. Dibs is an hourly volunteer program used to support each sport and step by step instructions will be available on our website. Volunteer opportunities will be communicated through our website.

At the start of each season, we will be asking for a pre-dated check from each family for the Dibs amount of \$300 per individual or \$500 family maximum per sport. These checks will be held in a safe deposit box at a local bank. If you do not wish to volunteer, please inform us in writing and we will deposit the check immediately. If volunteer hours are not fully met, the check will be cashed. If volunteer hours are met, the check will be destroyed. Partial reimbursement will not be given.

This is **not** intended to simply be a fundraiser for CSCR but to help increase the person-hours put into our programs for everyone's benefit.

Head coaches and board members are exempt from fulfilling Dibs requirements and specifics on assistant coaches will be provided for each sport as their season approaches.

SOFTBALL (8U Travel and older)

- \$300 deposit per player, max of \$500 per family
- 4 hours required per player during the 2026 season
 - Season runs Apr 1 through July 31
 - If a family has more than one softball player, each additional player's required hours shall be as follows
 - 2 players in one family = 6 hours
 - 3 players in one family = 8 hours
 - Maximum of 8 hours per family regardless of number of players
- Opportunities include:
 - Working the concession stand
 - Field prep and maintenance
 - Assisting with parking
- Keeping the scorebook for games does not qualify for volunteer hours.
- Up to 3 assistant coaches per team, identified by the director to the board prior to the start of the season, will receive half credit for their required hours.

- Volunteer hours signed up in advance for games which end up cancelled due to weather or forfeit will be honored and marked as complete.

VOLLEYBALL

- \$300 deposit per player, max of \$500 per family
- 4.5 hours required per player during the 2026 season
 - Season runs March 1 through May 9
 - Family maximum of 7 hours per family
- Opportunities include:
 - Tournament set up
 - Selling concessions
 - Selling admissions
 - Tournament clean up
 - Line judge for CSCR team
- Up to 2 assistant coaches, identified by the director to the board prior to the start of the season, will receive half credit for their required hours.

FOOTBALL

- There are no required volunteer hours for the 2026 season.

SOCCER

- There are no required volunteer hours for the 2026 season.
