The highlights of the meeting were as follows:

- The Board discussed association registration dates for the upcoming 2020-2021 for both new and returning players. The board decided that the initial registration amount will be \$600 for all divisions. Initiation will continue to allow four-year-olds to be registered for the upcoming season, thus the age group being ages 4-6.
- Due to Covid-19, the board discussed the status of ice fees from the rinks in the association after March 12.
- SHA Zone 1 Meeting videos and response surveys was sent to the board to review.
- Equipment returns to close out the 2019-2020 season will consist of assigned times to each Division. Collection will be done at the rink. WE will ask the Teams to report missing items or damages prior to the returns to minimize contact
- Due to Covid-19, the Board has agreed to allow teams registered with Plainsview Credit union to conduct outgoing etransfers. Contact the Board for the proper paperwork to do so.
- Midget Jerseys that are at the end of their lifecycle can be kept by the current players that were on these teams. Midget AA jerseys were new last year therefore should be returned during equipment collection.
- Discussion of the AGM. Due to Covid-19 and restrictions, in person meeting may not be possible. Consultation with our lawyer to ensure we are meeting bylaws will need to take place and alternatives will need to be determined.

- A survey will be sent out to all parents of female players within PSMHA. This will assist with planning and analytics for the upcoming year.
