

Homily Notes Guidelines

In an effort to help you get more out of your Mass attendance, we are asking you to take some time each week to think a little more deeply about what the message of the Liturgical Readings and the Homily mean to you.

After attending Mass on Sunday (or Saturday), we ask you to turn in a few notes on that weekend's Homily. **A minimum of 10 notes must be turned in each year during the candidate's 2 year preparation for a total of 20 notes.**

Your Homily Notes must include:

- the Date
- the name and city of the Parish you attended
- the name of the Priest celebrating the Mass
- and a 3-5 sentence summary of the Homily Message and what it means to you.

Notes can be emailed to Rebecca (cruxffc@acegroup.cc) or dropped off at the Parish Office no later than Noon on the Wednesday of the week you are turning in.
