



Hastings Hockey – GameSheet Start-Up Instructions/Guidelines

What is GameSheet:

- Approved by MN Hockey and MN District 8, GameSheet is a digital hockey game scoring platform that replaces the traditional paper score sheet. Being digital all scores, stats, rosters, and more are uploaded to the GameSheet cloud platform. GameSheet is run and managed off tablets (iPads) owned by the Hastings Hockey Boosters which will be kept at the Hastings Civic Arena.

- Where will the iPads be stored?
 - The iPads/tablets will be stored at the Hastings Civic Arena at the main office near the lobby.

- Do we need to bring the iPads/tablets with when we play an away game?
 - No, the home team will be responsible for utilizing their tablets to keep score and stats.
- What happens if the iPad has no battery left?
 - There will be 3 iPads at the Hastings Civic Arena... one for the west rink, one for the east rink and a spare. The spare iPad can be utilized
 - You can also plug in the iPad at the scoring station if the battery is low or needs re-charging and utilize it while it is charging
- Can we bring the iPads home?
 - No, the iPads/tablets MUST always remain at the arena.
- What if the iPads do not work?
 - If all the iPads are not able to be used, then defer back to utilizing the paper/carbon-copy scoring book. The information from the scorebook can be transferred to GameSheet at a later time.
- Where do I find the access codes if needed?
 - The access codes for GameSheet are provided by the District 8 webmaster at the beginning of the season.
 - The access codes will also be posted to the Manager's page on the Hastings Hockey website.
