Player Agents' Report –Registration (Hoyt)

- **Fall Baseball registration will be active mid-June.**
- **Clearances expire after 2 years and need to be renewed to coach this season.**
 - **Must be completed by first practice**
 - **All volunteers that will be interacting with the players will require this**
- **Each kid should get the opportunity to play any desired position with safety in mind. This is how we progress a kid's ability and interest in the game.**

Player Agent's Report –Scheduling (Willauer)

- **Sports Engine is up to date for all team games. Managers can add additional activities on their own, such as practices.**
- **If a game is cancelled due to weather, it is up to the Home Team Manager's responsibility to notify the umpire scheduled for that game – very important!**

Field Maintenance Report

- **Complex is in great shape – thank you to all who help to keep it that way!**

New/Old Business:

- **District/State Teams –**

 - **Tier and District/State Teams are completely separate from each other.**
 - **At least 1 roster move must be made from Tier to District/State Teams for each level. This includes at least 1 coach and 1 player.**
