

**IDAHO HIGH SCHOOL LACROSSE LEAGUE - HIGH SCHOOL BOYS**  
**MEETING MINUTES [DRAFT] OCTOBER 25, 2022 @ 6:30PM PDT | 7:30PM MDT**

**1. Roll Call - L. Doko** - Meeting called to order at 6:35PM PDT | 7:35PM MDT by Commissioner Adam Marfice *Present as below; simple majority present for regular voting; 2/3 present for by-law changes (9 of 13 teams present)*

*Palouse: CdA, Lake City, Logos*

*Teton: Hillcrest, Idaho Falls, Jackson Hole, Kimberly, Pocatello, Teton Valley, Wood River*

**2. Approve September 27, 2022 Minutes** - *John White/Lake City made 1st motion to approve; Aaron Herdt/Pocatello made 2nd motion to approve; all teams present voted unanimously on approving minutes.*

**3. Final IHSLL 2023 Spring Season Commitment** - *13 teams committed to IHSLL.*

**4. IHSLL By-Laws as of 9/27/22** - *Membership encourages Board to donate amended stipends back to IHSLL as membership and clubs as a whole are all volunteers. No formal changes made to by-laws as presented in the version updated as of 9/27/22. Aaron Herdt/Pocatello made the 1st motion to approve amended by-laws; John Lamm/Kimberly made the 2nd motion to approve; all teams present voted unanimously on approving amended by-laws.*

**5. Division Adjustment** - *Kimri Murphy/Hillcrest made the 1st motion to approve moving Kimberly back to Teton division. Mike Malko/Wood River made the 2nd motion to approve; all teams present voted unanimously on moving Kimberly to Teton division.*

**6. Divisional Directors** - *The East/Teton Division has selected Aaron Herdt as Divisional Director for the East. Palouse Division to submit their Divisional Director to Lauren and Adam by 11/1/2022.*

**7. IHSLL Website | Sports Engine | USA Lacrosse -**

*Website: IHSLL.com was purchased to allow the website to be visible and by-laws accessible. Sports Engine tech support redirected to allow the site to come back up. IHSLL.org is owned by IHSLL Board rep from years ago and expires 10/26/22 when IHSLL can consider repurchasing.*

*Sports Engine: Our website IHSLL.com is using the Sports Engine platform which is up for renewal at a cost of approx \$1,000 for the year, due Nov 2022. USA Lacrosse offers a free software platform, however, it does not track or have a place to enter stats.*

*The majority of the membership felt players are interested in stats, which is a strong motivator in the game, although it was noted colleges do not put much merit in stats as they are not taken consistently and are subject to errors.*

*Membership also agreed that asking parents to individually register players on Sports Engine was difficult; it was preferred to grant each club admin access to upload player rosters as a whole and bypass parent registration of individual players; this effort inspired the idea to survey clubs on which software platform they currently use for possible interface compatibility to streamline club player registration efforts.*

*MaxPreps may be an option to use for stats in conjunction with USA Lacrosse's platform. Regardless of which platform, current USA Lacrosse membership should be validated within the platform.*

7. (Continued) IHSLL Website | Sports Engine | USA Lacrosse -

IHSLL Software Platform Direction: Sports Engine remains a contender for IHSLL based on its ability to house stats. Adam and Lauren will further research other options such as Sports Connect, etc. Lyn Porterfield suggested IHSLL set up a demo meeting with USA Lacrosse to learn more about the platform.

Website Maintenance: IHSLL will need to determine who is in charge of the website/software platform, its maintenance and overall management.

8. **Postseason Discussion** - There were varying ideas on post season playoffs discussed, eg, 2 north and 2 east teams head to state playoffs to all teams going to playoffs. Commissioner Adam Marfice will send a survey to the membership to determine the direction the membership majority would like to go while also discussing official availability with ILOA. The results will determine the playoff format based on majority vote. One vote per team.

9. **IHSLL Treasurer** - Position remains open.

## OTHER NOTABLE DISCUSSION ITEMS

**All American Awards** - Lyn Porterfield advised the All American Awards and All Academic Awards are determined by # of teams in the league. Presently this is a split with SWILA, providing IHSLL with two All American Awards and two All Academic Awards. IHSLL also has the option to grant the Bob Scott Award to a qualifying high school senior.

IHSLL will need an Awards Chair by CYE 2022.
