On the chances created throughout the evening:

“We had good moments in the second half. We didn’t have a lot of chances in the first half aside from a few from distance, but we dominated the game in the second half. We got into good areas and we just have to take those chances. That was the difference – Atlanta got one good chance from the edge of the box and they took it well, and we obviously couldn’t take it in our end.”

On adjustments after the first half:

“Not really, just encouraging the players that we need to play behind a bit more. The way Atlanta plays is that they press high, so it’s playing them behind to use that space and try and create chances from there. Again, we did that really well in the second half but just couldn’t get the last shot on goal.”

On Indy’s defensive effort:

“I thought we defended quite well overall, to be honest. There were a couple of crosses into the box that cause a sort of half-threat in a sense, but overall I don’t think Jordan [Farr] had too much to do. As always, Atlanta causes problems for teams just with the pace and how they can move the ball, but I thought we did quite well.”
