#### **Approval of Minutes**

The minutes from the October meeting were approved.

#### General Update - Chris Johnson

- Introduction of any guests
  - None
- MBL/MBT Rules Committee Update
  - October 30, 2018 Rules Committee Meeting
    - Sportsmanship
      - 1. Discussed the many issues that were reported last year, several of which were fan based. The expectation is that coaches will police their own team much more so than in the past. Multiple team/Association complaints may result in game forfeitures.
      - 2. Any player, coach or fan other than the head coach who talks directly to the umpire will be ejected from the game.
      - 3. Use of profanity will be an automatic ejection
    - 14-year old continuous batting / free substitution
      - 1. No changes for the 2019 season for either MBL or MBT
      - 2. MYAS teams are able to declare at game time 9-player or continuous batting/free substitution. It is unclear if this includes tournaments at this time.
    - Pitching regulations
      - 1. No changes to MBL
      - 2. No changes to MBT regular season tournaments
      - 3. MBT State Tournaments will only expand pitch count if teams play in the 7TH game. Additional pitches will be allowed per player if teams advance.
    - Length of Season
      - 1. The 15AAA season will be reduced two MBL games from 16 to 14 games.
    - Number of coaches in dugout
      - 1. There will be 4 adults doing any role allowed in the dugout.
    - Additional Rules
      - 1. No player is allowed to pull back a bunt and take a swing at a pitched ball. A player is committed to either bunting the ball or taking the pitch. This rule is in place to keep the

3B from charging only to the hitter swing at a close range 3B. A swing will result in an automatic out and ejection.

    - V2 Defender Hockey Style Mask
  - o Currently worn by major league umpires and minor league catchers.
