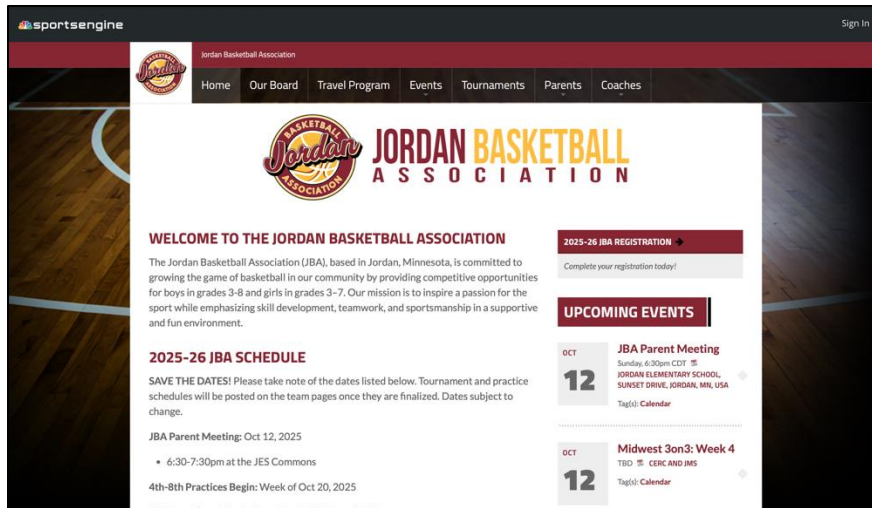

MYBA

What is the MYBA?

The Minnesota Youth Basketball Alliance (MYBA) is a collaborative effort between the Minnesota Youth Athletic Services (MYAS), the MYBA Basketball Board of Advisors, and youth basketball leaders from around the state working together to strengthen and enhance 3rd-8th grade community-based youth basketball during the winter season.



Benefits?

- **Widespread Participation:** Last season, 175 community-based youth basketball associations across Minnesota were members of the MYBA.
- **Access to the MYBA Tournament Index:** MYBA member associations using RegisterPlay Brackets can post their tournament(s) for free.
- **Exclusive Access to Grade State Championships:** Only teams from MYBA member associations are eligible to compete in the MYAS Grade State Basketball Championships.

- \$40.00 / shorts

Important: Your player will not be permitted to participate in practices or games until they are registered and all fees have been submitted.



JBA COACHES

The JBA relies on parent coaches for all grade levels. Coaches were selected by the Varsity Coaches after evaluations were completed, and teams were formed. All coaches are required to pass an annual criminal background check and complete online training on safety and concussion awareness through a program called Trusted Coaches.

PRACTICES

- 4th–8th grade teams will begin practice the week of October 20.
- 3rd grade teams will start the week of December 1.
- Each team will typically have two practices per week, with practice location and time varying based on gym and coach availability.
- Practice schedules – **coming soon** to the JBA website & Sports Engine app.
- JBA practice jerseys will be distributed by coaches and must be returned at the end of the season.



TOURNAMENTS

- 3rd grade: 5 tournaments, including MYAS State.
- 4th–8th grade: 8 tournaments, including the MYAS State.
- All tournaments will be pre-scheduled by the JBA and are held on weekends, with games scheduled on Saturday, Sunday, or both.

 - Boys 3rd - 6th: March 7 & 8
 - Boys 7th - 8th: March 14 & 15

PLAYING TIME

Provided a player is not frequently absent and demonstrates effort and appropriate engagement during practices and games, the JBA guideline promotes the following playing time minimums. Any absences due to illness, injury, or religious, school, or family events should be communicated in advance.

- **3rd–4th Grade:** Each player should receive at least **50%** of the total team playing time per game.
- **5th Grade:** Each player should receive at least **40%** of the total team playing time per game.
- **6th Grade:** Each player should receive at least **30%** of the total team playing time per game.
- **7th–8th Grade:** There is no minimum playing time requirement. Coaches have discretion over playing time but are reminded that the goal of travel basketball is to provide skill development, game experience, and a positive experience for every team member.



VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENT

JBA families (excluding coaches) are required to complete 2 volunteer shifts.

- A \$250 deposit check per family will be collected and held.
- Upon completion of your shifts, the check will be shredded.
- Unfulfilled volunteer hours will result in the check being cashed.

PARENTS

24-HOUR RULE - encourages parents and guardians to wait at least 24 hours after a game or practice before reaching out to a coach with concerns or issues. This pause allows emotions to settle, promoting more thoughtful and productive conversations. It also helps prevent impulsive reactions and gives both parents and coaches time to reflect and respond with a clearer perspective.
