1. Current Finances - Anderson

2. Booster Club Fundraisers

4. Coaches corner - Kuehn

- Irish Gives Back reward event is paintball this summer - coach Paul is organizing
- 2 game nets (with quick setup and Rosemount logo) will be purchased with district
- Lithium - will let us know, but only 1 player has signed up and he needs at least 20 players (1 scrimmage/week, one tournament July 30-31)
- All Irish Night - 101 kids signed up, needs help with creating/giving out swag bags night-of
- Bussing - only \$100 difference between coach bus vs school bus/trailer, planning on doing this more
- New district grading system with grade updates going out every 2 weeks - huge strides here, students stepping up and staying on top of grades
- Reffig - lots of opportunities, encouraging the players to do it
- Summer camps - currently sitting at low registration numbers
- State is adjusting 9th gr. LAX ordinance - if not following correctly could lead to not being able to play at state - Sept finalization of rules - could effect spring 14U league, but will have to wait and see

- End of Season tourney - May 29 and June 2
