



Mite/U8 Player Payment Policy

CRYHA is a non-profit organization. All of our programs are budgeted to break even at the end of each season. The player fees for each season, based on the level of play, must cover the costs of operating our CRYHA programs. These fees are determined each year based on our current operating costs, projected player counts, and best estimate of revenue from Sponsorships, Fundraising Initiatives and Charitable Gambling donations.

All Mite/U8 players will pay a registration fee (same for all levels of mites) at the time of registration for the season. First year Mite players (those players at the Mite/U8 age level that have never played hockey in CRYHA before) may have a reduced registration fee.

Mite A/B/U8:

Player fees for Mite A/B/U8 generally cover the following each season: practice ice, two (2) jamborees, District league play, player development activities, jersey and socks, and skills clinics. Any additional costs (e.g., equipment, etc.) are paid for directly by the player's guardian.

If a Mite A/B/U8 team decides to add additional practice ice, additional jamboree(s), practice jerseys, etc., the costs must be covered by the team directly. The team manager will be responsible for collecting money from each player's guardian and paying any fees directly (e.g., to the rink, association hosting jamboree, etc.). Any additional activities such as these will not be covered or paid for by CRYHA.

Mite A/B/U8 player fees will be collected in four (4) payments throughout the season. The first payment is due at registration as described above. The remaining payments are collected in November, December, and January through invoicing and electronic payment. Arrangements can be made to pay in full at the beginning of the season, if a guardian does not wish to use a credit card.

Mite C/D:

The registration fee for Mites as described above is the only fee for the season for players who are placed on teams at the C or D Mite level. This fee covers practice and game ice, player development activities, jersey and socks, and skills clinics. Any additional costs (e.g., equipment, etc.) are paid for directly by the player's guardian.

All players must be in good standing from the previous season prior to registration for the current season. This means that any and all outstanding past due accounts must be paid in FULL. Players will not be allowed to participate in tryouts if there is an outstanding prior year balance.

CRYHA Member Delinquent Player Acknowledgement

If payments are delinquent, all membership privileges for the player and guardians are revoked until the account is current and/or in compliance with the agreed upon payment plan.

This includes, but is not limited to:

- Practices
- Home and away games
- Tournaments where the team is registered as CRYHA or dressed in the CRYHA Hockey uniform
- Any on-ice or off-ice events affiliated with CRYHA

Revocation of membership privileges does not eliminate the player's season fees. The guardian will continue to be responsible for their player's fees for the remainder of the season.

In addition, delinquent accounts during the season may be subject to an additional 5% penalty of the outstanding balance.

All outstanding balances at the end of the season may be subject to an additional 10% penalty and must be paid by June 15 following the season. Individuals will not be allowed to register for the next season without paying off the delinquent amount, or have made satisfactory arrangements with CRYHA for payment of the delinquent amount.

Non-returning players with outstanding balances will be subject to collections and reporting to credit bureaus, unless satisfactory arrangements have been made with CRYHA for payment of the delinquent amount.
