Tryouts will have independent evaluators at each level and be run by Shaker Heights Youth Hockey Director Michael Berg and SYHA. The format will consist of individual skills evaluation, small close games and full ice scrimmaging. The cost is \$50 for returning SYHA players and \$75 for non SYHA players. The additional \$25 tryout cost for new players will go towards your Fall Hockey Registration if you decide to play for Shaker after tryouts. - *Tryout process with independent evaluators and tryout jerseys handed out to keep*
- *Provide “Player Safety Program” with baseline concussion testing in partnership with University Hospitals*
- *“Look up Line” has been added to Thornton Park Ice Rink*
- *In-Season Skills Sessions supplemented and instructed by Georgi Feduolov, Michael Berg, Russ Sinkewich of Ohio Hockey Project and Matt Bartley of SHHS*
- *Affordable pricing and fees (payment programs can be arranged through the city)*
- *Spring Hockey Program*
- *SYHA Community Engagement (Annual Parents Party)*
