



Inclement Weather | Rainout Policy

In the case of inclement weather or unsuitable field conditions all activities will be suspended until ACYSO feels it is safe to return to the fields. Practice and games will be cancelled or rescheduled for a later date if possible. Refunds/credits will not be issued due to inclement weather. We will only reschedule games and make every effort to get all games played within the season.

Given the crowded nature of our field schedules, ACYSO may be unable to reschedule or replay in-house league games which are cancelled or suspended due to weather or field conditions. Therefore, every effort will be made to proceed with scheduled games as long as it is safe to do so. If a rescheduling is needed, the game may be played during scheduled practice time. If teams do not share the same practice days/times, we will reschedule it to when space/ref is available.

When weather or field conditions are an issue, practice/games will sometimes be cancelled ahead of time. Such announcements will be posted on our home page, social media accounts, and shared with the volunteer coaches.

In the event of severe weather, ACYSO will adhere to The United States Soccer Federation (USSF) position on lightning safety/severe weather policy. In the event of thunder *or* lightning, games will be immediately halted. If lightning is within 10 miles of the complex all games and practices will be suspended. All parties are to quickly leave the field and seek shelter in a safe location. Players are not to return to the field - and the game will not be resumed - until 30 minutes after the last lightning strike within the 10-mile range.

Reasons for ACYSO game cancellations:

1. Closure of the complex (ASP & CC)
2. Unplayable playing surface
3. The presence of unsafe weather (rain, ice, temperatures, etc.)
4. Threat of severe weather
