

Wasco Baseball Spring Season Draft Rules Minor, Major & Grapefruit Leagues:

- Each team will need one (1) Board Approved Manager and a maximum of two (2) Board Approved Assistant coaches. The League Commissioner will help assign any teams needing a Board Approved Assistant coach prior to the draft.
- Players present at the tryout/evaluation shall be drafted. Players not present at the tryout/evaluation will be assigned to teams randomly, via a blind draft run by the Commissioner. Players registering after the draft has been completed, will be assigned to teams based on the continuing draft order, by registration date and time of registration completion.
- No trades will be allowed after the player is drafted. The Executive Committee may approve hardship reassignment of a player upon written request.

- **DRAFT ORDER:**
 - The Draft order will be determined by the descending order of “Average Score” of the players currently assigned to the team (“predetermined players”) in advance of the draft. These predetermined players will be the players of the Board Approved Managers and Assistant coaches.
 - The League Commissioner will select an independent panel to evaluate the predetermined players in advance of the draft. If a predetermined player does not participate in evaluation for any reason, they will be assigned the highest score.
 - Rounds 1-5 will be conducted in the same order. For example, Team A has 1st pick, Team B has the last pick in each of the first 5 rounds.
 - Beginning in the 6th round, the draft will be in reverse order in all even rounds. For example, Team B will have the 1st pick in round 6 and Team A will have the last pick.

- **ROUND OVERVIEW:**
 - Round 0: Head Coach’s predetermined player.
 - Round 1: All teams draft from the Draft Pool, according to their draft position.
 - Rounds 2 and beyond: Teams will be assigned 1 of the predetermined players per round. If A Manager or Assistant Coach has multiple players (siblings), the additional players above and beyond Round 2 will still be assigned in the following rounds.
 - For example, if a team has 4 predetermined players, Round 0 would be predetermined player #1, Round 1 would be a pick from the pool, Round 2 would be predetermined player #2, Round 3 predetermined player #3, Round 4 predetermined player #4.
 - Once all predetermined players are selected, the team will begin drafting from the pool of players according to their assigned draft slot.

- If a player has a sibling, that sibling will be placed on the same team. When the first sibling is drafted, the second sibling will automatically be that team’s pick in the immediate following round. No other team can draft the sibling.
