## **TOURNAMENT LOCATIONS:**

**Facilities will open for Entry 35-40 minutes prior to the first round of play.**

## **ADMISSIONS:**

Purchase your ticket online through TicketSpice or pay **EXACT** cash at the door (we will have limited change, so please be sure to pass this along to families that it needs to be as exact as possible.)

Separate fee will be charged each day. There are no weekend passes sold.

Entry fee will get you into all locations.

Adults (18+): \$20 for Weekend Pass, \$12 for Single Day

Students (6-17): \$12 for Weekend Pass, \$7 for Single Day

## **CONCESSIONS/OUTSIDE FOOD:**

Offered at the Fargo Parks Sports Center - outside food and drink are allowed just not in the playing areas.

## **SPECTATOR SEATING:**

Bleacher seating is available at Fargo Parks Sports Center, NO outside chairs allowed.

## **APPAREL:**

Northwest Designs will be providing tournament apparel.

## **AWARDS:**

The first and second place teams in the **GOLD BRACKET** of each age division will receive a medal.

### **SCHEDULE & RESULTS:**

All results will be posted on AES, results will populate every 5-8 minutes. The link to the schedule will go out when the schedule is posted.

### **FIRST AID/TRAINER:**

It is recommended that teams bring their own first aid kit. There will be no trainer, first aid or ice provided at the playing sites.

### **COACHES MEETING:**

There will be no coaches meeting, all information will be covered in this guide. There will be bag tags for all teams so make sure you get those before leaving.

### **VOLLEYBALLS:**

Please bring your own volleyballs to warmup with, they will not be provided by the facilities. Game balls **WILL** be supplied by the tournament hosts.

### **POOL PLAY INFORMATION:**

Warm up will be 10 minutes for the FIRST TWO MATCHES (2 min. shared/4 min serving team/4 min receiving team). There will be no switching sides.

After the first matches 5 minute warm up (1 min. shared/2minute serving team/2 minute receiving team.

4 Team Pools: Pool play will be 2/3 to 25 NO CAP (15 for 3rd Set)

3 Team Pool: Pool play will be 3 sets to 25 NO CAP.

**The COACH needs be the up official for Pool Play and Tournament Play.**

### **TIE BREAKING PROCEDURE:**

There will be no tie-breaking sets played. All placement in ties will be broken by the following:

1st: Set percentage

2nd: Point percentage

3rd: Coin Toss

**BRACKET PLAY:**

Check on AES for Bracket Placement

Tournament play is best 2/3 sets, with no cap.

Warm up for the first round matches will be 10 minutes.

Warmup for matches after the first round will be 5 minutes.

There will be no switching sides.

Tournament is predetermined based on seed from pool play.

**\*\*Please look at AES for working team updates in bracket play.\*\***

Please check with site director before leaving to make sure you are not missing a work assignment.

The COACH needs to be the up official for Pool Play and Tournament Play.

**12's Division:**

Nets will be lowered to 7 feet and then will be allowed to move 7 feet into the court to serve.
