



Lord Selkirk Minor Hockey 2018-2019 **FEE Breakdown and Information**

2017-2018 LSMHA Ice - \$195 per hour

2017-2018 Winnipeg Ice - \$207 per hour

All Players regardless of playing Skills, Novice – Midget Male or Female “A”, AA Male and Female, AAA male will need to register with LSMHA. Failure to do so will result in not being allowed to participate in any Evaluations” – Refunds and Fee transfers are explained at Bottom of page in LSMHA Fee Section.

LSMHA Fees – Please see bottom of page for fee details.

Tryout Fees – Evaluation Fees are now included in the cost of registration. All players from Novice – Midget “A” are required to participate in the evaluation process. There is no separate cost for Evaluations.

All players Novice-Midget are required to attend Team formation evaluation. These fees are included in the cost of registration

Community Center Fees

- There are no longer and Community Center Fees for Novice – Midget Hockey. There still may be some club fees associated with Skills. All programs Novice-Midget are LSMHA centralized programs and have no affiliation with Community Centers other than renting their facilities.
- LSMHA does have a \$25 per player cost that will be given to the Community Centers/facilities based on the amount of ice rented in a calendar year from the facility.

1. **Selkirk Youth Hockey** – (All Players North of HWY 67 including City of Selkirk, Clandeboye and Petersfield.
2. **East Selkirk Recreation Association** — (All Players located on the East Side of the Red River)
3. **St Andrews Community Center** — (All Players located on the West Side of the Red River and South of Hwy 67)

Skills Hockey Fees – Players Born 2012-2013

Fee Includes:

1. Hockey Canada Insurance Costs, Hockey Winnipeg and LSMHA Fees.

Each Community Center will collect fees as determined by their community center for Ice, tournament and other applicable fees.

LSMHA Fees

- Lord Selkirk Minor Hockey is the governing body of Hockey in this region and requires an operating Budget to ensure programs and costs are being met. The 2018-2019 operating Budget for LSMHA is \$90,000.
- All players regardless of where they play are required to contribute to the LSMHA operating budget which encompasses many expenses. Depending on what age you are the amount per player differs. All age groups will subsidize a different age group at a different time. If you would like more information on LSMHA operating budget you may come to a LSMHA board meeting and you will be shown the operating Budget for LSMHA:

LSMHA Fees:

- Admin Expenses – i.e.: Bank and Card Fees, Advertising, Corporation Fees.
- Website Fees and Maintenance
- Tryout Ice/Evaluators and Software
- Coach Equipment – All coaches are given Pucks/ First Aid Kits and other tools.
- Jersey Fee – All Players keep one Jersey at end of each season.
- Ice Subsidy – LSMHA incurs burnt ice each year for numerous reasons.
- Coach Development Programs
- Player and Goalie Development Programs and Days.
- Ref Clinic and Official Development
- City Championship Fund - \$500 to teams that win City Final
- Executive Honorariums – Funds to executive members and director to offset cost and time on programs.
- Other Costs associated with Minor Hockey.
- Evaluations
- Jerseys – Novice-Midget “A” Male Fishermen Teams will keep both Jerseys this year.

*LSMHA projects a balance budget each year. LSMHA executive pass the operating budget at a General Meeting. *
